Stubbs Wood

Aztec has now completed the removal of all agreed materials and will no longer be entering the woods,



except for occasional visits to manage pest species. This marks a significant step forward in restoring the natural peace of the area.

Our dedicated volunteers continue their efforts in Coup 1, carefully thinning and maintaining the woodland to promote healthy growth. They're also hard at work keeping the footpaths clear and views open throughout the summer months.

Excitingly, the team is beginning to uncover and restore some of the architectural woods' hidden features. These elements tell a rich story of how the woods have been used over the past few centuries. Plans are underway to share this history through educational displays for visitors. This project has already sparked local interest. with residents generously sharing historical knowledge and photosthank you!

We're also looking at reinforcing the main entrances to reduce incidents of fly-tipping and keep the woods secure for all.

Cllrs Fribbens and Manley are revising the existing woodland management plan in hopes of securing funding for the next two years. We're also arranging a community meeting this October, where a prospective woodland planning consultant will present ideas for the future.

In response, the Parish Council will be meeting with contractors to explore a balanced approach, including the creation of clear pathways through the meadow. Members are also committed to enhancing the space by planting native wildflowers, encouraging both biodiversity and community enjoyment.
