# 1. District Council - Silver Sunday Programme - Oct-Dec 2023

The Silver Sunday Programme for this year in being launched this week, with events starting 1 October.

Sandra will be adding to her submission over the next weeks, based on further data gathered on the infrastructure of and the residents along the A25.

# Air pollution

Michelle is finalising her letter to KCC on the significant toxicity to residents and older structures along the A25, caused by HGVs, particularly in the proposed daily numbers for several years, with particular exphasis on NOx emissions.
